

Writing Arabic or English Texts using {Taha} or {wAw} and {brAy} methods

Geometric Method {Taha} and writing Arabic way {wAw} are used equally for writing Arabic or English texts by typing Latin matching letters {lml} which can be transformed to Geometric letters {Taha} or to Braille matching letters {brAy } by using the proper font. Reversed (lml) lines are used in Arabic and reversed Geometric letters {Taham} are used in English.

Arabic text written using {Taha}, {lml} and {brAy} Alphabets

أنا الْبَحْرُ فِي أَحْشَائِهِ الدُّرُّ كَامِنٌ

{Im} MimAk urrudd- ihxAFcax If urcabl- Anax

“我說，你這人真會胡說八道，我跟誰說過了？——我跟誰說過了？”

فَهَلْ سَأَلُوا الْغَوَّاصَ عَنْ صَدَفَاتِي

(lml) - ItAfadaS naq aSAwwaQI- Ulaxas lahaf

English text written using {Taham}, {lml} and {brAy} Alphabets
