

Writing Arabic and English Texts using {Taha}, {wAw} and {brAy} Methods

Geometric method (**Taha**), Writing Arabic way {**wAw**} and unified Braille method {**brAy**} are used equally for writing Arabic and English texts by typing Latin matching letters (**lml**). By editing some capital letters we obtain Arabic or English (**wAw**) texts written from left to right.

Arabic (lml) text can be transformed into Geometric letters {Taha} or reversed {brAy} letters {brAym} by reversing the (lml) lines and by using the proper font. **English (lml)** text can be transformed into Mirrored Geometric letters {Taham} or {brAy} letters by using the proper font.
